A pre-bid conference will be held on-site to review the project and allow access to the site. The **pre-bid conference will be held at 10:00 am on April 10th, 2019** at the Whalehead Club at Historic Corolla Park, Corolla, NC. Please meet outside of the main entrance to the Whalehead Club building. **Attendance is not mandatory**.

The Project involves the construction of an approximately 9,100 square foot museum building and restroom adjacent to the Currituck Lighthouse site. It will house the historic boats stored on the Historic Corolla Park site.
