

**NOTICE TO BIDDERS**

Sealed bids will be received by Currituck County on the front steps of the Currituck County Historic Courthouse, 153 Courthouse Road, Currituck, North Carolina 27929, until **2:00 pm**, local time on **October 8, 2020**, and immediately thereafter publicly opened and read for the furnishing of labor, materials and equipment entering into the construction of:

*Whalehead Subdivision Drainage Improvements – Sailfish Street*

The Project consists of upgrading an existing groundwater lowering system including installation of directionally bored 6” and 8” HDPE force main, upgrades to an existing submersible pump lift station including pumps and electrical, installation of a drain pipe system, and landscaping.

Sealed bids may also be mailed to Rebecca Gay, Contract Purchasing Agent, Currituck County, 153 Courthouse Road, Suite 210, Currituck, North Carolina, 27929. It is the Bidder’s responsibility however, to make sure that its Bid is received at the bid opening location.

Bids will be received for single prime only. Bids shall be unit price bids based upon the units identified in the enclosed Bid Form.

A Pre-Bid Meeting will be held for all interested bidders at **2:00 pm on September 17, 2020** at the Whalehead Beach Sailfish Street Public Parking Lot located at the corner of Whalehead Drive and Sailfish Street, Corolla, North Carolina, 27927. The meeting will address project specific questions, issues, and bidding procedures. Attendance by prospective bidders is not mandatory.

Each bid shall be accompanied by a cash deposit or a certified check drawn on a bank or trust company authorized to do business in North Carolina, payable to the County of Currituck, in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the total amount of the bid, as a guarantee that a contract will be entered into. In lieu of cash or a certified check, the Bidder may submit a bid bond in the form prescribed in N.C. Gen. Stat. § 143-129.

The Successful Bidder shall be required to furnish a performance bond and a payment bond for one hundred percent (100%) of the contract amount.

No bid may be withdrawn after the scheduled closing time for the receipt of bids for a period of 30 days.

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All bidders must meet the licensing requirements under Chapter 87 of the N.C. General Statutes. Small Business Entities, Women Owned Businesses and Minority Owned Businesses are encouraged to submit bids.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive informalities, as it may deem to be in its best interest.
