



When should you call 9-1-1?

There are many time when 9-1-1 can help. Here are some examples:

- 1. To get help for someone who is hurt.
- 2. If you smell smoke or see a fire.
- 3. If you see someone stealing something.
- 4. If you see someone hurting someone else.

What should you say when you call 9-1-1?

- 1. Tell the person who answers what is wrong.
- 2. Tell them your name, address, and phone number.
- 3. Do not hang up until they tell you to hang up. They may have to ask you more questions.
