

Addendum No. 13 OSWWTP Phase 1 Replacement Project Corolla, Currituck County, North Carolina July 21, 2015

The following shall take precedence over the plans and specifications of the above named project and shall become part of the Contract Documents. Original items of the specifications, contract documents and information indicated on the drawings not herein modified, amended, voided or suspended shall remain in effect.

General

The following are questions posed by plan holders. The questions are in *italicized* text and the answers are in **bold** text.

1. For Bid Alternate 4 - Has the quantity of fill material available from the county been determined to be enough, quantity wise, to fulfill the needs of this contract?

The sum of lump sum bid items 1, 2, 3 & 4 will result in the Base Bid. The Base Bid shall be a turn-key lump sum value to complete the entire project. This Base Bid value shall include all of the fill material needed to complete the site work. Bid Alternate 4 is a deduct alternate that should represent the potential savings to the County should they supply the fill material to complete the site grading.

2. If additional fill material is required is that the intent of Item 7 from the unit price list?

The unit price sheet is to include price values for additional Change Order work. The unit price will often include a total value that includes materials, freight and labor. The unit price values are for additional work and it is understood that these values will not apply directly if there is a Change Order that results in a reduction of the scope of work.
