Summary of Addendum Three - Clarification:

The following Responses to Contractor Questions are revised or clarified (text in red has been added for clarification):

Responses to Contractor Questions:

1. Requirements for types of planting soils and soil amendments are specified in Section 32 93 00 PLANTS, Articles 2.2, 2.3 2.4, and 2.5. Contractor is responsible for providing soil analysis/testing and amending soils as recommended by soil analysis. Soil depths and planting bed preparation requirements for planting soils are specified in specification section 32 93 00 PLANTS, Articles 3.4 and 3.5. **Contractor is responsible for providing Imported Topsoil (Type 'C' Planting Soil per Section 329300.2.5.C) for all planting areas consisting of trees, shrubs, perennials, groundcovers, ornamental grasses and annuals to depths as indicated in Table 1 of Section 329300.3.4.A – MASS PLANTING AREA REQUIREMENTS – TYPE 'A' AND 'C' PLANTING SOILS. Provide 4" depth imported soil for all trees, shrubs, perennials, groundcovers and ornamental grasses within planting area as defined on drawings L161 and L162. Provide 2" depth imported soil for all annuals within planting area as defined on drawings L161 and L162.** The allowances as identified within specification section 01 21 00 are in addition to the quantities required for the specified planting areas; please provide a separate line item for each allowance item listed in 01 21 00. All allowances are to be included within the base bid totals.
