What you should know about

9-1-1

When should you call 9-1-1?

There are many time when 9-1-1 can help. Here are some examples:

1. To get help for someone who is hurt.
2. If you smell smoke or see a fire.
3. If you see someone stealing something.
4. If you see someone hurting someone else.

What should you say when you call 9-1-1?

1. Tell the person who answers what is wrong.
2. Tell them your name, address, and phone number.
3. Do not hang up until they tell you to hang up. They may have to ask you more questions.
