Subject: Addendum No. 2 to RFB for Carova Beach Park Boardwalk and Fence Replacement

This Addendum forms a part of the Contract Documents and modifies the Bidding documents dated October 20, 2025, with amendments and additions noted below. This Addendum must be acknowledged on the Bid Form. Failure to acknowledge receipt of Addendum No. 2 may result in your submission being declared non-responsive.

### **Response to Bidder Questions:**

- 1. Are bonds required?

  Answer: No bid bond/security, performance bond, or payment bond is required on this project.
- 2. Bid Form Page 2 of 2 has a line for Unit Price Allowance. What is this intended for? *Answer:* "Unit Price Allowance" was inadvertently left on the bid form. A new bid form is attached to this addendum with this removed.
- 3. Contract Page 1 of 4 Item 2 Contract Term says ninety (30) consecutive days from the issuance of the Notice to Proceed. Is it 90 or 30?

  Answer: The contract term will be 30 days. An updated contract Page 1 of 4 with this wording corrected is attached.
- 4. Sheet 3 of 3 The wood treatments shown in the Typical Section of Boardwalk and fence replacement Detail conflicts with the Notes and Typical View for All Construction Areas. Please provide clarification regarding required treatments for all pile and lumber. *Answer: Revised drawing is attached.*
- 5. Sheet 3 of 3 Notes The deck boards are called out as 2.5 cca. CCA (Chromated Copper Arsenate) is not recommended for use where there is human contact *Answer:* The deck boards and rails have been changed to 0.6 CCA (or equivalent).
- 6. Sheet 3 of 3 Notes Decking and Handrails reference .14 CA treatment. This is not a treatment used in this area. Usually those items are .31 CA-C or .23 MCA. Please advise which treatment is required.

Answer: See answer to #5.



7. Sheet 3 of 3 - Is it the intent for 6x6 pile to used as the fence post? These are designated as 2.5 cca

*Answer:* Yes – we do not expect much human contact with the fence posts.

8. When is the project supposed to start and be completed Answer: The County, Engineer, and Contractor will discuss the start time of construction at the pre-construction meeting once the project has been awarded. The County expects to issue a Notice to Proceed in December, but no later than in January, depending on coordination with Contractor.

The Bidder proposes and agrees if this bid is accepted to contract with the Owner, in the form of contract specified below, to furnish all necessary materials, equipment, machinery, tools, apparatus, means of transportation and labor necessary to complete the construction for which a bid is shown, in full accordance with the plans, specifications and Contract Documents, to the full and entire satisfaction of Currituck County with a definite understanding that no money will be allowed for extra work except as set forth in the General Conditions and the Contract Documents, for the sum as set forth hereinafter.

The Bidder shall submit a base bid – lump sum for all work required by the Contract Documents.

The lump sum price shall include labor, materials, overhead, tools, equipment, transportation, profit, insurance, taxes, site repair, clean-up and all other incidentals to cover the finished work.

The bid amount shall be shown in both words and figures. In case of discrepancy, the amount in words shall govern.

The Bidder further proposes and agrees hereby to commence work under this contract on a date to be specified in a written order by the Owner and shall fully complete all work thereunder within the time specified in the Contract. Applicable liquidated damages amount is as stated in the Contract.
