Inaredients:

3 tbsp garlic, minced 2 small onions, chopped

Cooking with Latesa...

- 2 cups mushrooms, sliced •
- 1/2 tsp salt

Stuffed Steak Rolls

- 1/2 tsp pepper 2 lbs flank steak
- 1 bunch baby spinach leaves
- Provolone, thinly sliced

Directions: Sauté first five ingredients in olive oil for 15-20 minutes. Salt & Pepper flank steak on both sides. Spread mushroom onion mixture on top of flank steak. Top with layer of fresh spinach and layer of provolone. Roll steak into cylinder and secure every inch with long picks. Slice steak roll every inch and brown on both sides in skillet with olive oil. Bake at 350 degrees for 10-15 minutes.
