Dear Olga Manzly and Roman Golovka,

This letter is intended to notify you of the issuance of CAMA Minor Permit No. OB2023-111 for proposed development by Laura Paknis and Four Seasons Pool Builders, at 2265 Sandfiddler Rd., Corolla in Currituck County. The authorized project consists of the construction of a new swimming pool, concrete deck and fence. The proposed project has been determined to comply with the Coastal Area Management Act and/or State Dredge & Fill Law, and the Rules of the Coastal Resources Commission. As such, a permit has been issued to authorize the development. I have enclosed a copy of the permit for reference.

If you wish to contest our decision to issue this permit, you may file a request for a Third-Party Appeal pursuant to N.C.G.S. § 113A-121.1(b). The Chair of the Coastal Resources Commission will consider the case and determine whether to grant your request to file a Contested Case Hearing in the Office of Administrative Hearings. The hearing request must be filed with the Director of the Division of Coastal Management in writing (email or hard copy) and must be received within twenty (20) days of the disputed permit decision.
